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Preface

The Office of Institutional Research has in its archives Nyack College *Factbooks* dating back to 1987. Over the years, these publications have proven to be an invaluable source of information for administrators, faculty, students and staff in their research, reporting, and decision-making activities.

Formatting changes have been necessitated this year by the first fall term enrollments in new sites and programs: traditional and ADCP programs in Washington, D.C., an ADCP program in Miami Valley, OH, and the MSE graduate program at the college's Rockland campus. All six ATS sites are reported, reflecting early fall courses in Western Pennsylvania and the Ukraine*, as well as in the new program at Simpson College in California. In order to provide the greatest level of detail possible to address the unique reporting needs of each of our programs and locations, you will note a small reduction in print type, as well as a separate appendix to detail the enrollment at ADCP locations. Once again, data for ATS is provided in a special supplement that can stand alone as a separate publication in order to meet the needs of the seminary for its own independent *Factbook*.

All enrollments are reported as of the end of the add/drop period for traditional programs, with walk-on enrollments in modular and fast-track courses as of October 15, 2002, included. As in the past, fall term enrollments in cohort programs such as ADCP and the new MBA degree program are based on the number of students who registered for a term between February 1 and July 31. Note that the initial cohorts of the MBA program, which began in September of 2002, will be reported in spring 2003 enrollment reports.

An electronic database file of all of the enrollment data reflected in these pages has been warehoused by the Office of Institutional Research in order to facilitate reporting and research at a more detailed level than what has been done in the *Factbook*. Please feel free to avail yourself of this and other resources of this office as the need arises by contacting me.

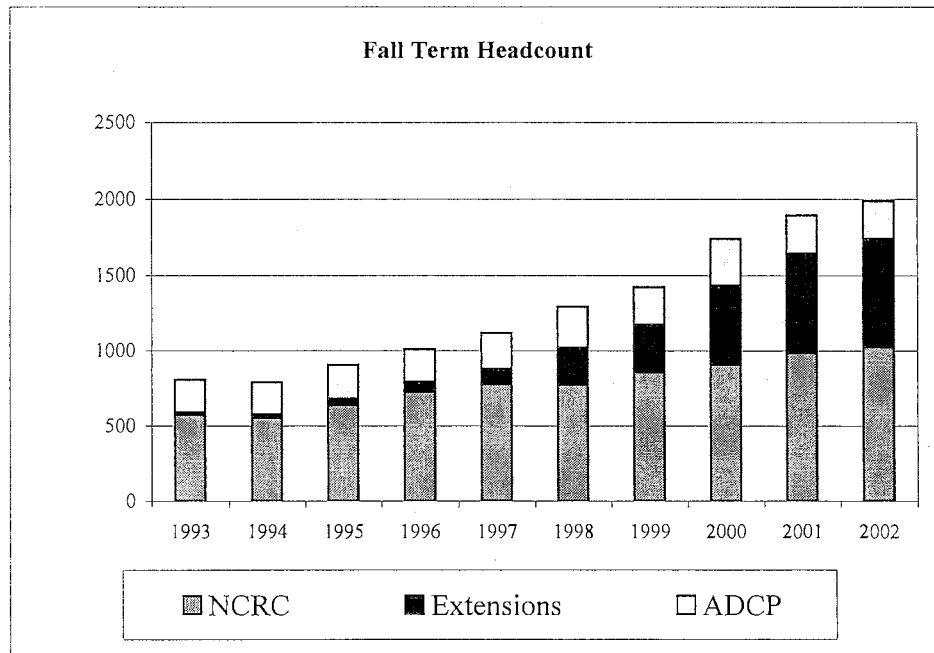

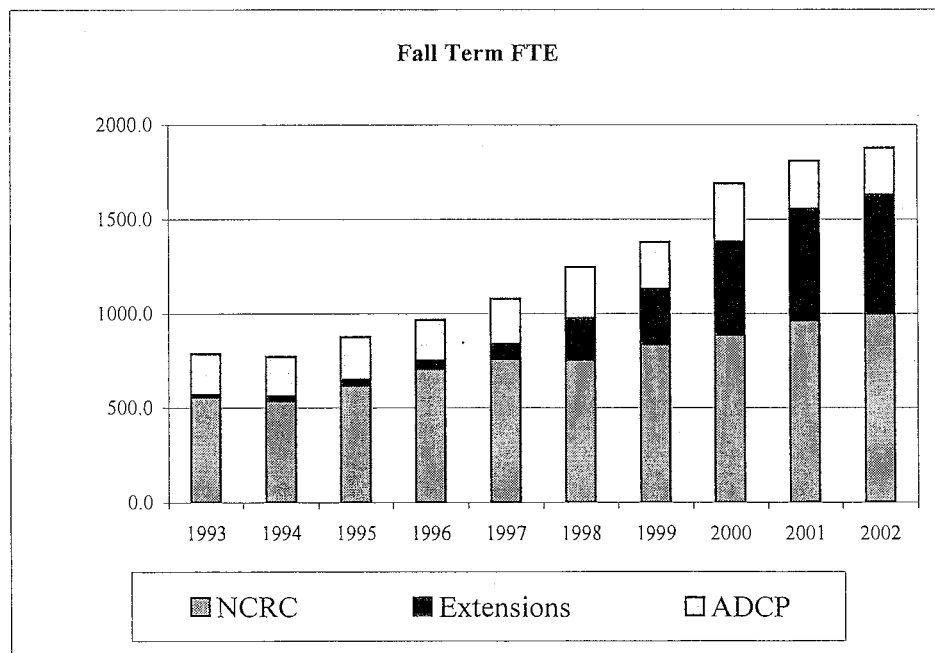

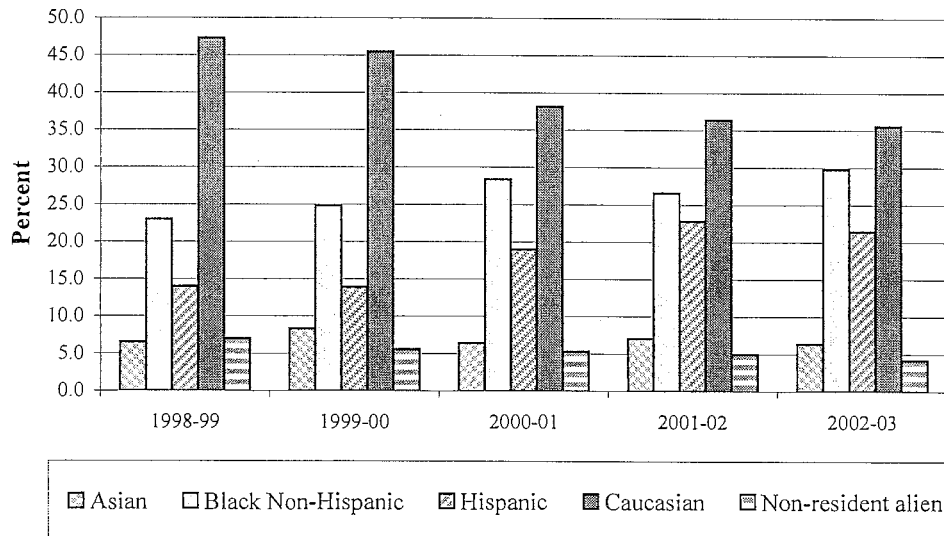

Historical Summary: Enrollment by Race



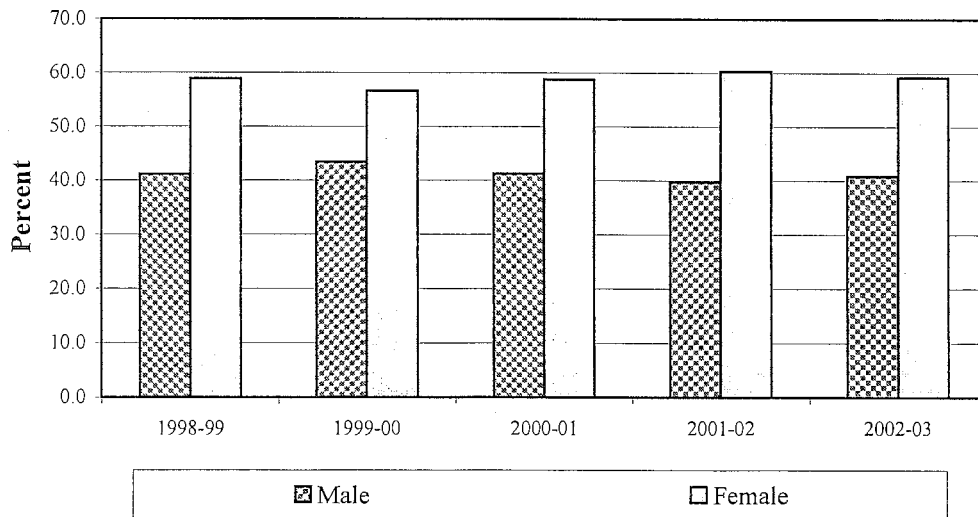
