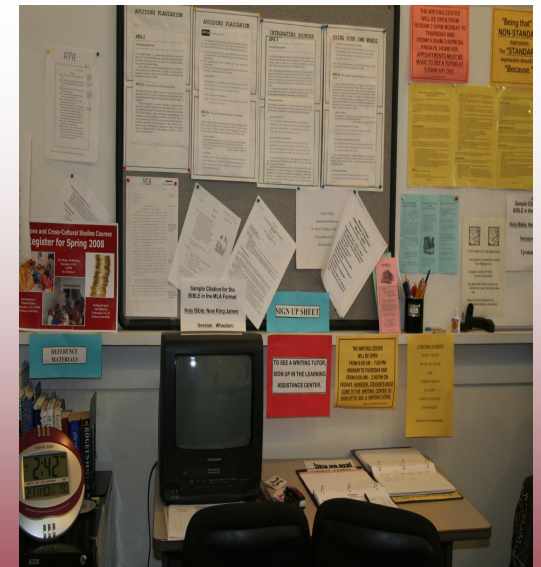

What You Must Do

1. Visit/contact the Writing center **ahead of time (use our website)** to make appointments with a writing tutor or the director.

4. You must bring the draft you are working on and be prepared to interact with the writing tutor to improve your paper.
5. Bring your finished draft.
6. Come with a positive attitude.
7. Be prepared to review your paper more than once.
8. Leave with self-evaluative skills.
